 - Generic drugs are listed in lower case letters.
 - The symbol* next to a drug signifies brand drug will convert to non-Formulary status when generic is available throughout the year.
 - The symbol [inj] next to a drug indicates that the drug is available in injectable form only.
 - The symbol [PA] next to a drug stands for Prior Authorization, which is needed prior to coverage of this drug, plan dependent.
 - The symbol [ST] next to a drug name stands for Step Therapy, which is in place on this drug, plan dependent.
 - The symbol [DQ] next to a drug name stands for Drug Quantity, which is a limitation on amount dispensed.
- For the member:** Generic medications contain the same active ingredients as their corresponding brand name medications, although they may look different in color or shape. They have been FDA-approved under strict standards.
- For the physician:** Please prescribe Formulary products and allow generic substitutions when medically appropriate.
